Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there has been a rise in the number of conflicts in the Jammu and Kashmir region since 2014;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the number of deaths of civilian and security personnel reported in the State during the said period, year wise;**
- (d) whether the insurgency activities are on the increase in the country;**
- (e) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and**
- (f) the special initiatives taken by the Government to reduce insurgency in Jammu & Kashmir and its impact thereon?**

ANSWER

**MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS
(SHRI HANSRAJ GANGARAM AHIR)**

(a) to (c) The State of Jammu & Kashmir has been affected by terrorist violence that is sponsored and supported from across the border. The levels of terrorist violence in the hinterland of J&K are linked to the infiltration from across the border. The details of terrorist violence incidents reported in Jammu and Kashmir during the last 3 years and current year are as under: -

(d) & (e) The trend of violence in the States affected by Left Wing Extremism activities has shown a decline since 2014. In the current year (upto 30.11.2017), LWE violence has decreased by 17.4% i.e. from 984 to 813 as compared to the corresponding period of 2016. The state-wise details is at Annex.-I.

The overall security situation in the North Eastern States improved substantially in 2016 in terms of reduction in violent incidents and security forces casualties. In the year 2017, there has been further improvement in the security situation in the region as number of insurgency incidents has further come down to 276 from 448 in the first eleven months of the year. While the States of Sikkim, Mizoram and Tripura have no insurgency related violence, the number of insurgency incidents has come down in Assam, Nagaland, Manipur and Meghalaya in 2017 (till November) compared to the corresponding period of 2016. However, there is increase in violent incidents in Arunachal Pradesh during the same period. The state-wise details is at Annex.-II.

(f) The Government regularly reviews the security situation in the State of Jammu and Kashmir and necessary directions are given from time to time. In order to prevent activities of militants, numerous steps have been taken including strengthening of operational grid with enhanced human intelligence and use of technical intelligence grid. The Government has also continuously encouraged policies to mainstream the youth, including providing employment opportunities to wean them away from militancy. Rs.80,068 crore has been announced under the PM Development Package, 2015.
